Call for papers: Workshop for young comparative law scholars

The Italian Society for Research in Comparative Law – SIRD is pleased to invite the submission of papers from young comparative scholars for the Workshop to be held on the 5th of April 2017, at the State University of Milan.

The purpose of the Workshop is to highlight and promote the scholarship of younger comparatists.

Format of the Workshop and Eligibility

Submissions on any subject in comparative constitutional, public or private law are welcome.

Proposals can be submitted either in Italian or English by scholars residing in Italy or in another European country.

The selected paper will be presented and discussed at the Workshop by a discussant.

Only individuals who have worked as lecturers, fellows, post-docs, research associates for no more than 10 years since their Phd are eligible. Graduate students enrolled in the last year of Phd programs are also eligible.

SIRD will select a maximum of **8 papers** for this workshop. SIRD may decide to increase the number of selected papers to extend participation to

the workshop if the number of deserving applications is higher than 8. In this case the workshop will run in parallel sessions.

the proposal with an attachment in Microsoft Word or PDF containing the Author's name; the e-mail address; the title of the abstract; an abstract of no more than 500 words.

The deadline to submit a proposal is the 17th of February 2017

By the 5th of March 2017 SIRD will communicate whether the paper is accepted. Papers that have been already published will not be accepted.

The final version of the paper is to be delivered at the above mentioned email address by 15 March 2017. The maximum length of the paper is 15.000 words (footnotes included).
